Students must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA each semester. Any semester in which the cumulative DYU GPA goes below 2.0, the student will be placed on probation for the following semester. If the student does not increase their GPA to 2.0 by the end of the 2nd semester after probation was first applied, the student may be dismissed from the program.

Admission criteria:

Students must hold an AAS or AS degree in dental hygiene from an accredited program and institution, and have a license to practice as a dental hygienist are eligible to apply. Official transcripts from ALL previously attended colleges/universities must be submitted
