

SEQUENCE FOR COMPLETING PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Students are expected to complete their program in the following sequence:

1. Completion of coursework, including internships or practicum, concurrently with the following activities:
2.
 - a. Completion of the thesis/dissertation proposal, thesis/dissertation proposal presentation, IRB application, thesis/dissertation, thesis/dissertation defense and thesis/dissertation presentation day;
 - b. **or** Completion of the project and its related activities as determined by each graduate program.
3.
 - a. Review and approval of the thesis/ dissertation manuscript by the office of graduate studies outside reader;
 - b. **or** Approval of the project as determined by each graduate program.
